13 EARTH BECOMING UNINHABITABLE

WHAT ARE THE SIGNS OF CLIMATE CHANGE IN GLASGOW?

This summer, torrential rain submerged one street under four feet of water. If it rains too much the Clyde could one day overflow. Climate change leads to extreme weather events that change human conditions of life and in some parts of the world, people have to move out of their homes.

HOW MANY PEOPLE ARE FACING RISKS OF FLOODING?

In Glasgow, around 170,000 people face risks from flooding. Around the world, 1,5 billion people might one day have to move to a different country.

WHAT ARE OTHER CAUSES OF CLIMATE-INDUCED MIGRATION?

Because of climate change, some parts of the world are becoming uninhabitable. Flooding, heat waves, drought or vanishing of natural resources (such as forests) can lead people and animals to search for a new home and to become climate refugees.


